

COOKIE POLICY

1. Data Controller

Kilda ("the Platform") is a non-commercial, open-access platform for stress-testing exchange-traded funds against climate-related risks. The Platform is operated by an individual based in Sweden with project collaborators in Spain, Belgium, and the United Kingdom. For the purposes of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 ("GDPR") and all applicable data-protection law, the operator acts as data controller. Contact: hello@kilda.app.

2. Scope

This policy covers cookies and similar tools (including local storage, session storage, and pixel tags) deployed on kilda.app. References to "cookies" include all such technologies.

3. Cookies Deployed

The Platform does not deploy analytics, advertising, behavioural-tracking, or social-media cookies. No cookie deployed on this Platform requires user consent under Article 5(3) of Directive 2002/58/EC ("ePrivacy Directive").

The only cookie that may be present is an **infrastructure session identifier** set automatically by the hosting provider and not under the direct control of the operator. Its exact name varies by provider. This cookie is classified as strictly necessary: it routes HTTP requests to the correct server instance during a browsing session, contains no personal data, and is not used for identification, profiling, or tracking. It is session-scoped and automatically deleted when the browser is closed. Its legal basis is the exemption from consent under Article 5(3) of the ePrivacy Directive, which applies to cookies strictly necessary for the provision of a service explicitly requested by the user.

If the hosting provider does not set this cookie, the Platform operates with zero cookies. This section will be updated within fourteen (14) calendar days of any change.

4. Third-Party Cookies

No third party sets, reads, or receives data from cookies through this Platform. If this changes, this policy will be updated and, where required by law, consent obtained before activation.

5. Managing Cookies

Because the Platform uses only strictly necessary cookies (or none), no consent banner is displayed. You may block or delete cookies through your browser settings. Blocking strictly necessary cookies may impair functionality.

6. Your Rights

EU/EEA and United Kingdom. Under the GDPR and UK GDPR, you may request access to, rectification or erasure of, restriction of processing of, and portability of your personal data, and may object to processing. Because the Platform does not collect personal data through cookies, these rights are not engaged by cookie use. You may also lodge a complaint with your local supervisory authority.
